STATE- WIDE COMMIT MENT

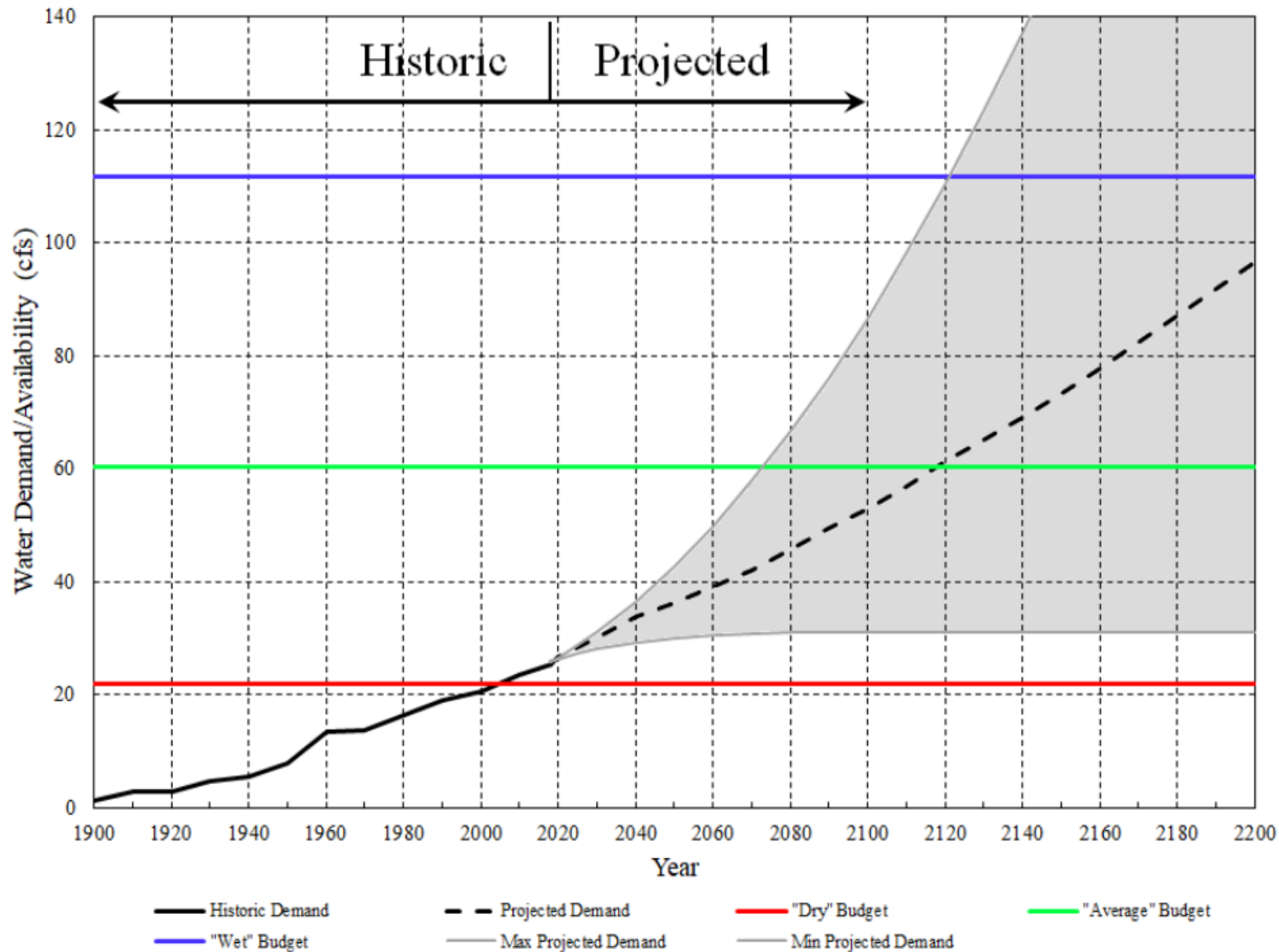


Norbeck

- **1918—Constitutional Amendment** allowing the State of South Dakota to purchase, own, develop and operate plants for the development of power
 - Upon streams of the state
 - At coal mines upon lands owned by the state
- **1919—Legislation creating the Hydro-Electric Commission**
 - Governor Peter Norbeck, Chair
 - Doane Robinson, Secretary
- **1921—Formation of the South Dakota Hydro Club**
 - Doane Robinson, J.W. Parmley of Ipswich, William Potts and Julius Skaug of Mobridge
- **1922—Initiated measure for on \$16 million dam**
 - Proponents—the South Dakota Hydro Club—“the Missouri can be made a great asset. Now it is a menace.”
 - Opponents—the South Dakota Tax Payer League—“funding the hydroelectric project would be like dumping South Dakotans’ money in the river.”
 - Defeated by a 2:1 margin
