1 **An Act to revise provisions regarding cost reimbursement associated with medical**
 2 **cannabis.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That § 34-20G-27 be AMENDED:**

5 **34-20G-27.** Nothing in this chapter requires:

- 6 (1) A government medical assistance program or private health insurer, workers'
 7 compensation insurance carrier, or self-insured employer providing workers'
 8 compensation benefits, to reimburse a person for costs associated with the medical
 9 use of cannabis;
- 10 (2) Any person or establishment in lawful possession of property to allow a guest,
 11 client, customer, or other visitor to smoke cannabis on or in that property; or
- 12 (3) A landlord to allow the cultivation of cannabis on the rental property.
