Senate Joint Resolution 501

A JOINT RESOLUTION, to apply to Congress under Article V of the United States
Constitution to call a convention for an amendment to the Constitution
establishing congressional term limits.

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF
- 5 Representatives concurring therein:
- 6 **Section 1. The South Dakota Le**gislature hereby makes an application to Congress, as
- 7 provided by Article V of the Constitution of the United States of America, to call a convention
- 8 <u>limited to proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America to set</u>
- 9 a limit on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a Member of the United States
- 10 House of Representatives and to set a limit on the number of terms that a person may be
- 11 elected as a Member of the United States Senate.
- 12 Section 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to transmit copies of this
- 13 **application** to the President and Secretary of the Senate of the United States and to the
- 14 Speaker, Clerk, and Judiciary Committee Chairman of the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Congress of the United States, and copies to the members of the said Senate and House of
- 16 Representatives from this State; also to transmit copies hereof to the presiding officers of
- 17 each of the legislative houses in the several States, requesting their cooperation.
- 18 Section 3. This application shall be considered as covering the same subject matter
- 19 as the applications from other States to Congress to call a convention to set a limit
- 20 on the number of terms that a person may be elected to the House of
- 21 Representatives of the Congress of the United States and the Senate of the United
- 22 States; and this application shall be aggregated with same for the purpose of attaining the
- 23 two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress to call a limited convention on this subject,
- 24 but shall not be aggregated with any other applications on any other subject.

- 1 **Section 4. This application constitutes** a continuing application in accordance with Article
- 2 V of the Constitution of the United States of America until the legislatures of at least two-
- 3 <u>thirds of the several states have made applications on the same subject.</u>
