State has need for nurses even without COVID-19 pressure



SIOUX FALLS, S.D. (KELO) – Even before the coronavirus pandemic, South Dakota was experiencing a shortage of nurses.

While it's making progress in adding new nursing students and graduates, projects say the state will be 1,900 nurses short of need by 2030, multiple research reports and nursing organizations have reported.

It will be one of seven states with a projected shortage.

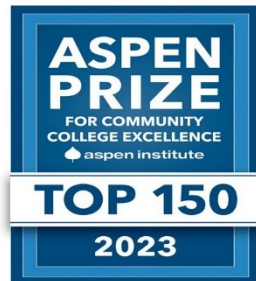
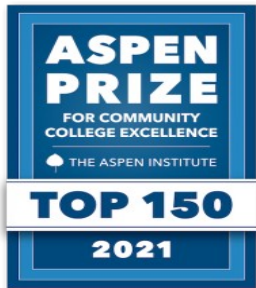

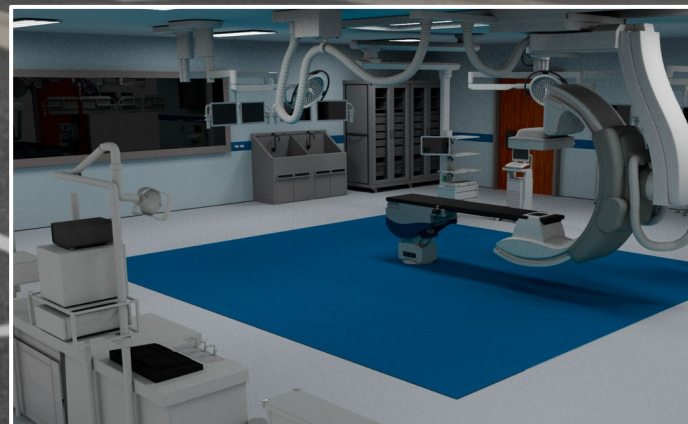
Multi-Use Facility

PTIONS

Health Sciences Clinical Simulation Agreement

1. City provides lease of downtown property for \$1 per year for StartUp Sioux Falls move to downtown for ten years.
2. Chamber and Development Foundation lease Zeal to STC for for five years with renewal for additional five years. Annual funding for lease will be provided by Forward Sioux Falls to STC Foundation.
3. \$5.25 million purchase price for Zeal building will be reduced by lease payments. After 10 years STC will purchase Zeal for \$3 million.
4. Sanford/Avera will provide funds for the renovation/remodel of the Zeal Building.
5. State provides funds for equipment to match funds provided by Sanford, Avera, and Forward Sioux Falls.

TIMELINE

Summer 2021 ZEAL building will be placed on the market for sale

June 2021 South Dakota Joint Appropriations visits Sioux Falls

September 2021 Discussions with Sanford Health, Avera, Sioux Falls Development Foundation, Chamber of Commerce, and City of Sioux Falls

November 2021 Secure commitment and begin renovation planning

December 2021 State Tech Board New Program Application – Behavioral Health Technician, AAS (AVERA) ; Allied Health, Certificate; Community Health Worker, Certificate (SDDOH)

January 2022 Legislature in Session – Equipment request (part of Governor's Proposed Budget)

Fall 2023 Launch of simulation center with expanded healthcare programming
