# Senate Bill 13

AMENDMENT 13A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

## 1 An Act to <u>modify and</u> repeal provisions permitting certain documents to serve as 2 temporary registry identification cards for medical cannabis.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

### 4 Section 1. That § 34-20G-38 be AMENDED:

34-20G-38. Until a qualifying patient who has submitted an application and the
required fee to Pending receipt of a registry identification card from the department,
receives a registry identification card or a denial, a copy of the patient's application,
written certification, and proof that the application was submitted to a printed copy of
proof that the application was approved by the department is deemed a valid registry
identification card for a period of thirty days from the date of approval.

#### 11 Section 1. That § 34-20G-38 be REPEALED:

12 Until a qualifying patient who has submitted an application and the required fee to the 13 department receives a registry identification card or a denial, a copy of the patient' s 14 application, written certification, and proof that the application was submitted to the 15 department is deemed a registry identification card.

### 16 Section 2. That § 34-20G-39 be REPEALED:

- Until a designated caregiver whose qualifying patient has submitted an application
   and the required fee receives a registry identification card or a denial, a copy of the
   qualifying patient's application, written certification, and proof that the application was
   submitted to the department is deemed a registry identification card.
- 21 Section 3. That § 34-20G-40 be REPEALED:

#### 4 Section 4. That § 34-20G-41 be REPEALED:

- 5 Until twenty-five days after the department makes applications available, the 6 following is considered a designated caregiver registry identification card:
- 7 (1) A copy of a qualifying patient's valid written certification issued within the previous
   8 year; and
- 9 (2) A signed affidavit attesting that the person has significant responsibility for 10 managing the well-being of the patient and that the person has been chosen to
- 10Imanaging the weir being of the patient and that the person has11assist the qualifying patient.
