House Bill 1091

1 **An Act to authorize the Board of Regents to contract for the design and construction**
 2 **of a year-round rodeo practice facility on the campus of South Dakota State**
 3 **University, together with equipment and furnishings, to make an**
 4 **appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency.**

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 **Section 1.** The Board of Regents may contract for the design and construction of a year-
 7 round rodeo practice facility, with boarding stables and a feed storage shed, on the campus
 8 of South Dakota State University in Brookings, together with furnishings and equipment,
 9 including heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks,
 10 parking, landscaping, architectural and engineering services, and other services or actions as
 11 may be required to accomplish the project, for a total construction cost of up to \$10,000,000.

12 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5,000,000 and
 13 appropriated the sum of \$5,000,000 in other fund expenditure authority for the purposes
 14 authorized in section 1 of this Act.

15 **Section 3.** The cost estimates contained in this Act have been stated in terms of 2021 values.
 16 The Board of Regents may adjust such cost estimates to reflect inflation as measured by the
 17 Building Cost Index, reported by the Engineering News Record, and additional expenditures
 18 required to comply with regulations adopted after the effective date of this Act. However, any
 19 adjustments to construction cost estimates for the project may not exceed one hundred
 20 twenty-five percent of the estimated project construction cost stated in section 1 of this Act.

21 **Section 4.** The Board of Regents may accept, transfer, and expend any moneys obtained for
 22 the project authorized in this Act from federal sources, donations, or any other external
 23 sources, all of which comprise a special fund for the benefitted project.

1 **Section 5.** The administration of the design and construction of the project authorized in this
2 Act shall be under the general charge and supervision of the Bureau of Administration as
3 provided in chapter 5-14.

4 **Section 6.** The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the
5 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

6 **Section 7.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
7 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.

8 **Section 8.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
9 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
10 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
