



Statewide Water and Sewer Infrastructure Funding

Bureau of Administration – SB 50

Overview

Governor Noem's recommended budget includes \$60,000,000 in one-time American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding to support eligible improvements to water and sewer infrastructure projects throughout the state. This funding will boost the core infrastructure that currently serves, in a number of cases, aging campuses.

This funding will be provided to the state agencies listed below to make improvements to the water and sewer infrastructure at facilities operated by those agencies. The ability to use these one-time funds will free up future maintenance and repair funding for other meaningful and important improvement projects.

\$60,000,000 of the funding has been recommended to be provided to various state agencies, including the Board of Regents and Technical Colleges, to make improvements to the water and sewer infrastructure at facilities operated by those agencies. The ability to use these one-time funds will free up future maintenance and repair funds for other meaningful and important improvements projects.

Description

Water and sewer infrastructure throughout our state facilities need repairs and upgrades. These projects will be managed by the Office of the State Engineer (OSE) using the same process currently used to manage Statewide Maintenance and Repair; Game, Fish and Parks; Board of Regents; Social and Human Services; and other agency maintenance and repair projects. Projects will be reviewed with each campus and prioritized to address the most critical needs first. OSE will work with each campus to complete projects with the least amount of disruption to their mission.

Funding

State agencies have proposed 125 projects totaling \$60 million, which would provide 100 percent of the eligible water and sewer infrastructure related costs for these improvement projects. Together this funding will make meaningful investments in water and sewer infrastructure projects across the state, which will have long lasting benefits for future generations.
