On page 2, line 7, of the House Health and Human Services Engrossed bill, delete "No person may engage in the practice of optometry, display a sign, or in any way advertise or hold oneself out as an optometrist, unless the person holds a current license issued by the board pursuant to this chapter. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor" and insert "It is a Class 2 misdemeanor for any person who is not the holder of a certificate of registration or exemption, issued and recorded as provided in this chapter, to practice or offer to practice optometry within the state"
