SB 22	revise a reference to the Division of Criminal Investigation. (Introduced)
HB 1059	permit nonresponsive insurance producer applications be deemed withdrawn as to not constitute a refusal or administrative action. (Introduced)
HB 1062	revise a provision regarding when a license is not required of a person installing electric wiring. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 11	(Deferred from 10 th LD) revise provisions regarding the medical marijuana oversight committee. (Introduced)
SB 12	(Deferred from 10 th LD) revise the annual report on medical cannabis by the Department of Health to the Legislature. (Introduced)
SB 19	(Removed from Consent) provide that health care facilities, mental health centers, and accredited prevention and treatment facilities may establish reasonable restrictions related to the medical use of cannabis. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)
SB 7	revise provisions related to custody and visitation rights by medical cannabis cardholders. (Introduced)
SB 16	repeal provisions related to the prosecution, search, seizure, penalty, or discipline of medical cannabis establishments for certain conduct. (Introduced)
