1 **An Act to modify the licensing of barbers.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1. That § 36-14-9 be AMENDED:**

4 **36-14-9.** The Board of Barber Examiners may promulgate reasonable rules,
 5 pursuant to chapter 1-26, for the administration of the provisions of this chapter and to
 6 prescribe sanitary requirements for barbershops and barber schools. A copy of the rules
 7 promulgated by the board shall be furnished by the board to the owner or manager of
 8 each barbershop and barber school. A copy of the rules shall be posted in a conspicuous
 9 place in each barbershop or barber school.

10 The Board of Barber Examiners may also promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-
 11 26, to establish:

- 12 (1) The fee to apply for a certificate of registration for barbers, pursuant to section 3 of
 13 this Act;
 14 (2) The fee to transfer a barber license or registration to this state, pursuant to § 36-
 15 14-14;
 16 (3) The fee for the annual renewal of the certificate of registration for barbers pursuant
 17 to §§ 36-14-22 and 36-14-24; and
 18 ~~(2) The fee for the operation of a barber school or college pursuant to § 36-14-24;~~
 19 ~~(3)(4) The fee for the operation of a barbershop pursuant to § 36-14-27; and~~
 20 ~~(4) The procedures governing the inspection of barbershops and the barbershop~~
 21 ~~equipment pursuant to § 36-14-28.~~

22 **Section 2. That § 36-14-13 be AMENDED:**

23 **36-14-13.** Any person who ~~is at least eighteen years of age and has passed a~~
 24 ~~satisfactory examination conducted by the Board of Barber Examiners to determine the~~

1 ~~person's fitness to practice barbering~~ meets the following requirements is entitled to a
2 license or certificate of registration as a registered barber:

3 (1) Is at least eighteen years old;

4 (2) Demonstrates competent, ethical behavior to qualify as a barber, as determined
5 by the Board of Barber Examiners;

6 (3) Completes fifteen hundred hours of education or equivalent credit hours in a barber
7 college approved by the board; and

8 (4) Satisfactorily passes the written test and practical barber demonstration certified
9 by the board. ~~is entitled to a certificate of registration as a registered barber.~~

10 **Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added:**

11 Any person desiring to practice barbering in this state must make an application to
12 the Board of Barber Examiners. The application must:

13 (1) Contain proof the person met all criteria required pursuant to § 36-14-13
14 ; and

15 (2) Be accompanied by a fee to be determined by the board, which may not exceed
16 one hundred dollars, pursuant to § 36-14-24.
