1 **An Act to establish fees for information provided from the statewide voter**
 2 **registration file.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That chapter 12-4 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

5 The fees for obtaining a copy of an electronic file with voter registration information
 6 are as follows:

7 (1) Statewide complete file, one thousand two hundred fifty dollars;

8 (2) Statewide complete file for new parties or parties with alternative political status
 9 for just their party voters:

10 (a) Ten dollars for one thousand names or less;

11 (b) Twenty-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;

12 (c) Fifty dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names, inclusive;

13 and

14 (d) One hundred twenty-five dollars for more than twenty-five thousand
 15 names;

16 (3) Legislative district complete file, fifty dollars;

17 (4) County or any other district complete file:

18 (a) Ten dollars for one thousand names or less;

19 (b) Twenty-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;

20 (c) Fifty dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names, inclusive;

21 and

22 (d) One hundred twenty-five dollars for more than twenty-five thousand
 23 names;

24 (5) Any updated partial file that contains only changes made within a year after the
 25 purchase of a complete file:

26 (a) One hundred twenty-five dollars for a statewide partial file; and

- 1 (b) Fifteen dollars for a legislative district, any other district, or county partial
2 file.

3 **Section 2. That chapter 12-4 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

4 The fees for obtaining a paper list with voter registration information are as follows:

- 5 (1) Statewide complete list, five thousand five hundred dollars;
6 (2) Statewide complete list for new parties or parties with alternative political status
7 for just their party voters:
8 (a) Twenty dollars for one thousand names or less;
9 (b) Seventy-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
10 (c) Two hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
11 inclusive; and
12 (d) Six hundred dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
13 (3) Legislative district complete list, two hundred dollars;
14 (4) County or any other district complete list:
15 (a) Twenty dollars for one thousand names or less;
16 (b) Seventy-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
17 (c) Two hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
18 inclusive; and
19 (d) Six hundred dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
20 (5) Any updated partial list that contains only changes made within a year after the
21 purchase of a complete list:
22 (a) Five hundred fifty dollars for a statewide partial list; and
23 (b) Sixty dollars for a legislative district, any other district, or county partial
24 list.

25 **Section 3. That chapter 12-4 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

26 The fees for obtaining a copy of an electronic file with daily absentee voter
27 registration information per election are as follows:

- 28 (1) Statewide complete file, one thousand five hundred dollars;
29 (2) Legislative district complete file, seventy-five dollars; and
30 (3) County complete file:
31 (a) Thirty-five dollars for one thousand names or less;
32 (b) Fifty dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;

- 1 (c) Seventy-five dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
2 inclusive; and
3 (d) One hundred fifty dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names.

4 **Section 4. That § 12-4-39 be AMENDED:**

5 **12-4-39.** The secretary of state may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26
6 concerning:

- 7 (1) Procedures for the establishing the statewide voter registration file;
8 (2) Transmission of the voter registration information from the county to the Office of
9 the Secretary of State;
10 (3) Procedures for determining duplicate voter registration; and
11 (4) Dissemination of the information from the statewide voter registration file; and
12 ~~(5) Establishment of fees for information provided from the statewide voter registration~~
13 file.
