

# Senate Bill 96

Make an appropriation to the Board of Regents to renovate the science laboratories in the Churchill-Haines building at the University of South Dakota.




### REQUEST: \$10 MILLION

- Churchill-Haines is home to USD's Department of Chemistry.
- A one-time appropriation of \$10 million will update chemistry laboratories that have not been renovated since Churchill-Haines was constructed in 1974. Without facility investment, USD risks losing faculty researchers who attract a significant amount of external research funding each year (\$7M in the past five years).
- Renovation will include upgrades to interior finishes as well as upgrades to plumbing, HVAC and electrical systems.




By renovating USD's laboratories all at once instead of gradually updating, USD could realize significant savings due to increases in construction costs each year.

Churchill-Haines 127A & B Renovated in 2021




USD's chemistry department contributes significantly to USD's economic impact to South Dakota. **Over the past five years, the department received approximately \$7M in research awards to faculty members.**
