- An Act to establish employees' exemptions from employer-imposed COVID-19 vaccine requirements.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 60-2 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- 5 No employee in this state may be required by an employer to receive a COVID-19 6 vaccination if the employee submits to the employer: 7 A written statement from a physician stating that the COVID-19 vaccination is 8 contraindicated for medical reasons; 9 (2) A signed statement from the person in which the person dissents and objects to receiving a COVID-19 vaccine on religious grounds, which includes moral, ethical, 10 11 and philosophical beliefs or principles; or 12 (3) A signed statement from the person attesting to the person's immunity by prior 13 COVID-19 infection. 14 This section does not apply to service members of the South Dakota National

Guard, who are subject to federal activation pursuant to Title 10 of the United States

Code.
