- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require the Department of Labor and Regulation to
- determine certain job placement outcomes for graduates of all public postsecondary
- 3 education institutions in the state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. The Department of Labor and Regulation shall annually work with the Board of
- 6 Regents to determine the job placement outcomes for those persons completing a degree
- 7 program at an institution under the control of the Board of Regents. The department shall also
- 8 annually work with the Board of Education to determine the job placement outcomes for those
- 9 persons completing a degree program or training program at a public postsecondary technical
- 10 institute in the state.
- 11 Section 2. The Department of Labor and Regulation shall compile the information received
- pursuant to this Act and provide it to the Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council
- 13 no later than November fifteenth of each year.
