House Bill 1169**AMENDMENT 1169A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

1 **An Act to modify the licensing of barbers.**

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1. That § 36-14-9 be AMENDED:**

4 **36-14-9.** The Board of Barber Examiners may promulgate reasonable rules,
5 pursuant to chapter 1-26, for the administration of the provisions of this chapter and to
6 prescribe sanitary requirements for barbershops and barber schools. ~~A copy of the rules~~
7 ~~promulgated by the board shall be furnished by the board to the owner or manager of~~
8 ~~each barbershop and barber school. A copy of the rules shall be posted in a conspicuous~~
9 ~~place in each barbershop or barber school.~~

10 ~~The Board of Barber Examiners may also promulgate rules, pursuant to chapter 1-~~
11 ~~26, to establish:~~

12 ~~(1) The fee to apply for a certificate of registration for barbers, pursuant to section~~
13 ~~3 of this Act;~~

14 ~~(2) The fee to transfer a barber license or registration to this state, pursuant to §~~
15 ~~36-14-14;~~

16 ~~(3) The fee for the annual renewal of the certificate of registration for barbers~~
17 ~~pursuant to §§ 36-14-22 and 36-14-24; and~~

18 (2) The fee for the operation of a barber school or college pursuant to § 36-14-24;

19 (3)(4) ~~The fee for the operation of a barbershop pursuant to § 36-14-27; and~~

20 (4) ~~The procedures governing the inspection of barbershops and the barbershop~~
21 ~~equipment pursuant to § 36-14-28.~~

22 **Section 2. That § 36-14-13 be AMENDED:**

23 **36-14-13.** Any person who ~~is at least eighteen years of age and has passed a~~
24 ~~satisfactory examination conducted by the Board of Barber Examiners to determine the~~

1 ~~person's fitness to practice barbering~~ meets the following requirements ~~is entitled to a~~
2 license or certificate of registration as a registered barber:

3 (1) Is at least eighteen years old;

4 (2) ~~Demonstrates competent, ethical behavior to qualify as a barber, as determined~~
5 ~~by the Board of Barber Examiners~~ Submits an application in compliance with § 36-
6 14-18;

7 (3) Completes fifteen hundred hours of education or equivalent credit hours in a barber
8 college or school approved by the board; and

9 (4) ~~Satisfactorily passes~~ Passes ~~the written test and practical barber demonstration~~
10 ~~certified by the board.~~ is entitled to a certificate of registration as a registered
11 barber.

12 **~~Section 3. That a NEW SECTION be added:~~**

13 ~~Any person desiring to practice barbering in this state must make an application to the Board~~
14 ~~of Barber Examiners. The application must:~~

15 (1) ~~Contain proof the person met all criteria required pursuant to § 36-14-13~~

16 ~~;~~ and

17 (2) ~~Be accompanied by a fee to be determined by the board, which may not exceed one~~
18 ~~hundred dollars, pursuant to § 36-14-24.~~

19 **Section 3. That § 36-14-18 be AMENDED:**

20 **36-14-18.** Each applicant for an examination or initial registration as a barber
21 pursuant to § 36-14-14 shall make application to the Board of Barber Examiners on blank
22 forms prepared and furnished by the board, setting forth, under oath, the particular
23 qualifications of the applicant, and. An applicant by examination shall furnish to the board
24 two five-by-three inch photographs of the applicant, one of which shall be returned to the
25 applicant and presented to the board when the applicant appears for examination. The
26 application shall be accompanied by the required fee.
