AMENDMENT 53C FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1An Act to make an appropriation to increase workforce housing and to declare an2emergency.

- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** <u>There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$150,000,000 and</u>
- 5 appropriated the sum of \$50,000,000 in federal fund expenditure authority to the Governor's
- 6 Office of Economic Development (GOED) for purposes of increasing housing supply across
- 7 South Dakota.
- 8 Section 2. Funds shall be administered through the Local Infrastructure Improvement
- 9 Program pursuant to the criteria outlined in § 1-16G-50.
- 10 Section 3. GOED's share of the funding shall not exceed one-third of total project costs, with

11 the remaining portion to be provided by an equal match from a local governmental entity and

- 12 <u>the project developer.</u>
- 13 Section 4. The commissioner of the GOED shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
- 14 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 15 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 16 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 17 Section 6. Any individual with a beneficial ownership interest, either directly or indirectly, of
- 18 five percent or greater in a project that receives any of the federal grant funds under section
- 19 <u>1 of this Act will be reported to GOED. The beneficial interest must be determined and reported</u>
- 20 at the time the grant funds are disbursed. GOED shall report to the legislature by June first
- 21 of each year, until the federal grants have been fully expended.

- 1 Section 7. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of state government and its existing
- 2 public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force
- 3 and effect from and after its passage and approval.
