## House Bill 1334

JOINT APPROPRIATIONS ENGROSSED

Introduced by: The Joint Committee on Appropriations

- An Act to make an appropriation of American Rescue Plan Act moneys for certain home and community-based services, and to declare an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$80,000,000 in federal fund expenditure
- 5 <u>authority for the expenditure of American Rescue Plan Act Section 9817 moneys, to the</u>
- 6 <u>Department of Human Services, for the purpose of allocating the moneys to certain home and</u>
- 7 community-based services for one-time compensation adjustments, retention incentives,
- 8 <u>direct care work recruitment and training, telehealth, or assistive technology equipment.</u>
- 9 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$13,600,000 in federal fund expenditure
- 10 authority for the expenditure of American Rescue Plan Act Section 9817 moneys, to the
- 11 Department of Social Services, for the purpose of allocating the moneys to certain home and
- 12 <u>community-based services for one-time compensation adjustments, retention incentives,</u>
- direct care work recruitment and training, telehealth, or assistive technology equipment.
- **Section 3.** The secretary of the Department of Human Services shall approve vouchers for
- 15 appropriations provided in section 1 of this act. The secretary of the Department of Social
- 16 Services shall approve vouchers for appropriations provided in section 2 of this Act. The state
- 17 auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 18 **Section 4.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by June
- 19 <u>30, 2026, shall revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 20 **Section 5.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 21 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 22 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
