- An Act to establish fees for information provided from the statewide voter registration file.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 12-4 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

19		(c) One hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
20		inclusive; and
21		(d) Two hundred fifty dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
22	<u>(5)</u>	Any updated partial file that contains only changes made within a year after the
23		purchase of a complete file:
24		(a) Two hundred fifty dollars for a statewide partial file; and
25		(b) Twenty-five dollars for a legislative district, any other district, or county

(1)	Statewide complete list, five thousand five hundred dollars;
<u>(2)</u>	Statewide complete list for new parties or parties with alternative political status

	(a) Twenty dollars for one thousand names or less;
	(b) Seventy-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
	(c) Two hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
	inclusive; and
	(d) Six hundred dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;
<u>(3)</u>	Legislative district complete list, two hundred dollars;
(4)	County or any other district complete list:
	(a) Twenty dollars for one thousand names or less;
	(b) Seventy-five dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names, inclusive;
	(c) Two hundred dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand names,
	inclusive; and
	(d) Six hundred dollars for more than twenty-five thousand names;

	The fees for obtaining a copy of an electronic file with daily absentee voter
regist	ration information per election are as follows:
<u>(1)</u>	Statewide complete file, three thousand dollars;
<u>(2)</u>	Legislative district complete file, one hundred fifty dollars; and
<u>(3)</u>	County complete file:
	(a) Sixty-five dollars for one thousand names or less;
	(b) One hundred dollars for one thousand one to ten thousand names,
	inclusive;
	(c) One hundred fifty dollars for ten thousand one to twenty-five thousand
	names, inclusive; and

Section 4. That § 12-4-39 be AMENDED:

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3	12-4-39. The secretary of state may promulgate rules pursuant to chapter 1-26
4	concerning:

- (1) Procedures for the establishing the statewide voter registration file;
- 6 (2) Transmission of the voter registration information from the county to the Office of 7 the Secretary of State;
 - (3) Procedures for determining duplicate voter registration; and
- 9 (4) Dissemination of the information from the statewide voter registration file; and
- 10 (5) Establishment of fees for information provided from the statewide voter registration 11 file.
