SENATE JUDICIARY ENGROSSED

Introduced by: **Senator Rohl**

1 **An Act to revise the automatic removal of certain convictions from a background**
 2 **check record.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That § 23A-3-34 be AMENDED:**

5 **23A-3-34.** ~~Any charge or conviction resulting from a case where a~~ case consisting
 6 of the following charges or convictions must be automatically removed from a defendant's
 7 public record five years after disposition if all court-ordered conditions on the case have
 8 been satisfied and the defendant has not been convicted of any further offenses within
 9 those five years:

- 10 (1) ~~A case in which all charges are petty-offense offenses, municipal ordinance violation~~
 11 ~~violations, or a Class 2 misdemeanor was the highest charged offense shall be~~
 12 ~~automatically removed from a defendant's public record after five years if all court-~~
 13 ~~ordered conditions on the case have been satisfied and the defendant has not been~~
 14 ~~convicted of any further offenses within those five years.~~ misdemeanors; or
 15 (2) A case in which all charges are petty offenses, municipal ordinance violations, Class
 16 2 misdemeanors, and Class 1 misdemeanors for the use or possession of marijuana
 17 or any derivative of marijuana.

18 Following the removal of any charge or conviction under this section, no person
 19 may be held under any provision of law to be guilty of perjury or of giving a false statement
 20 by reason of the person's failure to recite or acknowledge the person's arrest, indictment
 21 or information, or trial in response to any inquiry made of the person for any purpose.
 22 However, the case record remains available to court personnel, the Division of Criminal
 23 Investigation, or as authorized by order of the court and may be used as an enhancement
 24 in the prosecution of subsequent offenses as provided by law.
