Senate Concurrent Resolution 607

1 **A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Encouraging the South Dakota High School Activities**
 2 **Association to sanction baseball.**

3 WHEREAS, the sport of baseball has a rich history in South Dakota, where large and small
 4 communities alike come together to support America's pastime. Thousands of South Dakotans
 5 compete at all levels of baseball each year, with some players going on to compete at the
 6 highest levels in the nation; and

7 WHEREAS, South Dakota is one of only two states, including Wyoming, that does not have
 8 sanctioned high school baseball through its statewide activities association; and

9 WHEREAS, in 2021, fifteen Class A teams and thirty-eight Class B teams were registered
 10 with the South Dakota High School Baseball Association, totaling fifty-three teams
 11 representing nearly seventy-five South Dakota schools. More South Dakota schools would
 12 have the opportunity to participate if the sport was sanctioned; and

13 WHEREAS, with recent successes in the Little League World Series and the Babe Ruth
 14 World Series by South Dakota teams on a national scale, baseball will continue to grow as a
 15 popular sport in this state, opening opportunities for young players to compete; and

16 WHEREAS, while club baseball is thriving in this state, there are significant advantages to
 17 being an officially sanctioned sport, including greater access to competition, enhanced status,
 18 and financial support;

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature of
 20 the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the South
 21 Dakota High School Activities Association should pursue the process of sanctioning baseball.
