Senate Concurrent Resolution 608

Introduced by: Senator Novstrup

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, to conduct an interim study examining local jails and 2 opportunities for collaboration with state correctional plans.

- 3 <u>WHEREAS, South Dakota counties have the responsibility to provide local jails to</u>
- 4 accommodate local offenders; and
- 5 WHEREAS, several South Dakota counties struggle to provide adequate local jail facilities
- 6 for meeting law enforcement and inmate sentencing needs; and
- 7 WHEREAS, South Dakota will soon commence a state-wide correctional plan process; and
- 8 WHEREAS, counties have not been involved in the state's correctional plan development
 9 process to date; and
- 10 <u>WHEREAS, there may be strategic opportunities for collaboration among the state and</u>
 11 <u>counties to efficiently and effectively meet state and local needs; and</u>
- 12 WHEREAS, strategic partnerships among state and local officials regarding correctional
- 13 <u>needs have served the state well in the past, specifically regarding the South Dakota Women's</u>
- 14 Prison located in Pierre; and
- 15 <u>WHEREAS, it would serve the state well to involve counties in the state's correctional plan</u>
 16 process:

17 <u>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature of</u> 18 <u>the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the</u> 19 <u>Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council establish an interim study regarding local</u> 20 correctional needs across the state and opportunities for collaboration within the state's

- 21 correctional plan, so that efficient and effective solutions among local and state leaders may
- 22 <u>be realized.</u>
