House Concurrent Resolution 6011

1 **A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, declaring August thirty-first as Young Republicans**
2 **Day.**

3 WHEREAS, the initially elected Executive Board of the South Dakota Young Republicans,
4 consisting of President Larry Luetke, Vice President John Haverhals, Secretary Carrie Srstka,
5 Treasurer Cole Heisey, National Committeeman Spencer Wrightsman, and National
6 Committeewoman Danielle Haugan, worked tirelessly with the National Young Republican
7 Executive Board to ensure the South Dakota Young Republicans were re-chartered as a state
8 chapter in good standing under the Young Republicans National Federation guidelines; and

9 WHEREAS, the Young Republicans are the oldest political youth organization in the United
10 States. Important to the growth of the Republican Party, the Young Republicans reach out to
11 registered Republicans and provide them with better political knowledge and understanding
12 of current issues; and

13 WHEREAS, the South Dakota Young Republicans are leaders from across the United States
14 who put conservative principles into action. They are the future of the Republican Party and
15 fight to keep the American Dream alive by recruiting new young conservatives, training future
16 leaders, and electing Republican candidates; and

17 WHEREAS, the Young Republicans provide an opportunity to achieve political expression
18 and recognition, more effectively participate in the election process, and better develop and
19 uphold the principles of the Republican Party as a service to the United States, the State of
20 South Dakota, and the state's political subdivisions:

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Ninety-
22 Seventh Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that August
23 thirty-first is declared to be Young Republicans Day to highlight the valuable work of the South
24 Dakota Young Republicans.
