House Bill 1044**AMENDMENT 1044C FOR THE SENATE ENGROSSED BILL**

1 **An Act to adopt the 2021 edition of the Uniform Plumbing Code, and allow for**
2 **selective adoption of provisions within the Uniform Plumbing Code by**
3 **municipalities.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1. That § 36-25-15 be AMENDED:**

6 **36-25-15.** The commission shall, ~~in compliance with~~ by rules promulgated
7 pursuant to chapter 1-26, adopt and publish minimum standards relative to the design,
8 construction, installation, improvement, extension, and alteration of materials, piping,
9 venting, fixtures, appliances, and appurtenances in relation to plumbing and plumbing
10 systems. All plumbing and plumbing systems ~~shall~~ must be designed, constructed,
11 installed, improved, extended, and altered in substantial accord with the requirements of
12 the ~~2015~~2021 Uniform Plumbing Code, International Association of Plumbing and
13 Mechanical Officials, as in effect January 1, ~~2015~~2021, and ~~such amendments~~ any
14 amendment or revision to the code adopted by the commission to protect the health, life,
15 safety, and welfare of persons and property in this state.

16 ~~The governing body of any local unit of government may delete any portion of the~~
17 ~~Uniform Plumbing Code before adopting the provisions within. Additional deletions or~~
18 ~~amendments to the adopted provisions of the Uniform Plumbing Code may be made by~~
19 ~~the governing body, and are effective upon their filing with the county auditor.~~

20 **Section 2. ~~That § 36-25-16 be AMENDED:~~**

22 ~~**36-25-16.** Nothing in this chapter shall prohibit any municipality by ordinance from making~~
23 ~~and enforcing requirements and standards regarding plumbing, and from making inspections~~
24 ~~and collecting fees relating thereto. Any such ordinances shall be deemed the applicable~~

1 ~~standards as to any plumbing work in such municipality, provided that the standards as~~
2 ~~contained in such ordinances meet the minimum standards of the State Plumbing Code as~~
3 ~~adopted by the commission and altered as provided for in this section or section 1 of this Act,~~
4 ~~and that any person registered by the commission may do plumbing work in such municipality~~
5 ~~for a period of six months following application for a permit or license in said municipality.~~

6 ~~The governing body of any local unit of government may delete any portion of the State~~
7 ~~Plumbing Code before adopting the provisions within. Additional deletions or amendments to~~
8 ~~the adopted provisions of the State Plumbing Code may be made by the governing body, and~~
9 ~~are effective upon their filing with the county auditor.~~
