Senate Bill 198**AMENDMENT 198D FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS
ENGROSSED BILL**

1 **An Act to establish an interim committee regarding alternatives for the placement**
2 **of juvenile offenders.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** An interim juvenile placement committee is established to consider and develop
5 alternatives for the placement of juvenile offenders, develop findings, report on the findings,
6 and recommend legislation. ~~The speaker shall appoint five members of the House of~~
7 ~~Representatives and three members of the public, at least two with involvement in public~~
8 ~~education. The president pro tempore shall appoint five members of the Senate and three~~
9 ~~members of the public, at least two with involvement in public education. The Governor shall~~
10 ~~appoint eight individuals.~~

11 The committee must consist of:

- 12 (1) Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
13 House of Representatives;
- 14 (2) Four members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
15 Senate;
- 16 (3) Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the speaker of the
17 House of Representatives;
- 18 (4) Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the president pro
19 tempore of the Senate;
- 20 (5) One mental health professional, appointed by the speaker of the House of
21 Representatives;
- 22 (6) One mental health professional, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
23 Senate;
- 24 (7) One addiction and prevention professional who provides services primarily to
25 juveniles, appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

- 1 (8) One addiction and prevention professional who provides services primarily to
2 juveniles, appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate; and
3 (9) Three persons representing the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, appointed
4 by the Governor.

5 If there is a vacancy on the committee, the vacancy may be filled in the same
6 manner as the original appointment.

7 The committee shall be under the supervision of the Executive Board of the
8 Legislative Research Council and staffed and funded as an interim legislative committee.

9 The committee shall deliver its report and recommended legislation to the
10 Legislature by January 1, 2023.
