13	The Gove	rnor shall appoint eight individuals.
14		The committee must consist of:
15	(1)	Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
16		House of Representatives;
17	<u>(2)</u>	Four members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the
18		Senate;
19	<u>(3)</u>	Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the speaker of the
20		House of Representatives;
21	<u>(4)</u>	Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the president pro
22		tempore of the Senate;
23	<u>(5)</u>	One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the
24		speaker of the House of Representatives;
25	<u>(6)</u>	One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the
26		president pro tempore of the Senate;

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1	<u>(7)</u>	One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector
2		and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the speaker of the House
3		of Representatives;
4	<u>(8)</u>	One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector
5		and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the president pro
6		tempore of the Senate;
7	<u>(9)</u>	One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the speaker of the House
8		of Representatives;
9	(10)	One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the president pro tempore
10		of the Senate; and
11	<u>(9)</u>	Two persons representing the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, appointed by
12		the Chief Justice of the South Dakota Supreme Court.
13		If there is a vacancy on the committee, the vacancy may be filled in the same
14	mann	er as the original appointment.
15		The committee shall be under the supervision of the Executive Board of the
16	Legislative Research Council and staffed and funded as an interim legislative committee.	
17		The committee shall deliver its report and recommended legislation to the
18	Legisla	ature by January 1, 2023.
