### Synopsis

On September 13, 2020, the South Dakota Division of Criminal Investigation (SDDCI) requested that the North Dakota Bureau of Criminal Investigation (NDBCI) assist the South Dakota Highway Patrol (SDHP) with a fatality accident investigation. It was reported that on September 12, 2020, at approximately 10:25 p.m., South Dakota Attorney General JASON RAVNSBORG struck a pedestrian on South Dakota Highway 14 west of Highmore, South Dakota, in Hyde County resulting in a pedestrian being killed. At the time of the accident, it was believed JASON RAVNSBORG had struck a deer. The deceased individual was not discovered until approximately 8:30 a.m., on September 13, 2020.

- On September 13, 2020, at approximately 10:28 a.m., numerous special agents from the North Dakota Bureau of Criminal Investigation (NDBCI) were requested to assist the South Dakota Division of Criminal Investigation (SDDCI) regarding a deceased individual, later identified as Joseph Paul Boever, found at the scene of what was originally believed to be a vehicle hitting a deer accident. Agents were advised of the following:
  - A. South Dakota Attorney General (AG) JASON RAVNSBORG had been in what was believed to be a vehicle hitting a deer accident on the night of September 12, 2020.
  - B. An accident report was taken.
  - C. On the morning of September 13, 2020, a deceased male (Joseph Boever) was located at the scene of the accident.
  - D. South Dakota Highway Patrol (SDHP) would conduct the accident investigation.
  - E. NDBCI was being requested to process JASON RAVNSBORG's vehicle and conduct the necessary interviews along with digital forensics.
