1. On October 23, 2020, Supervisory Special Agent (SS/A) Arnie Rummel made phone contact with Dr. Kelly Mills, who performed the autopsy on Joseph Boever, and discussed the timeline of the final report and opinions of the direction of the vehicle strike. Dr. Mills stated that due to the amount of frontal trauma, it would indicate that Joseph Boever was struck from the front.
 2. SS/A Rummel contacted Dr. Mills and inquired about the 190ng/ml of Lorazepam that was found in Joseph Boever's system. Dr. Mills requested to have the dosage and quantity amounts that were prescribed provided to her.
 3. SS/A Rummel contacted Sergeant Shane Snyder and was provided a Prescription Monitoring Report for Joseph Boever (Attachment #1).
 4. On November 19, 2020, SS/A Rummel provided the information to Dr. Mills, who stated that Joseph Boever was overmedicating but did not have the 300ng/ml amount that would be fatal.
