AMENDMENT HR7002A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

A RESOLUTION, Providing for the impeachment of Jason Ravnsborg, Attorney General of the State of South Dakota, for certain crimes and for malfeasance in office.

- 4 <u>WHEREAS</u>, the attorney general of the State of South Dakota is a state officer subject to
- 5 impeachment pursuant to S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 3; and

6	WHEREAS, the House of Representatives has the sole power of impeachment pursuant to
7	S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 1; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the House of Representatives that its sole power of 9 impeachment should only be exercised in grave and exceptional circumstances; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to S.D. Const. Art. III, § 31, the Legislature called itself into special
 session on November 9, 2021, for the purpose of investigating and evaluating whether the
 conduct of Jason Ravnsborg, Attorney General of the State of South Dakota, surrounding the

13 death of Joseph Boever, involved impeachable offenses, under S.D. Const. Art. XVI, § 3; and

- WHEREAS, in recognition of the gravity of an impeachment inquiry, the House of
 Representatives made a thorough investigation by holding hearings and taking evidence; and
- 16 <u>WHEREAS, the House of Representatives provided Attorney General Ravnsborg the</u>
- 17 opportunity to participate in the House's impeachment proceedings, including the opportunity
- 18 to provide testimony and to submit factual and legal arguments; and
- WHEREAS, the House of Representatives developed an extensive record of documentary
 evidence; and

1	WHEREAS, Attorney General Ravnsborg committed certain crimes while operating a motor						
2	vehicle, which led to and directly caused the death of South Dakota resident Joseph Boever,						
3	and which Attorney General Ravnsborg pleaded no contest to at his criminal trial; and						
4	WHEREAS, in Attorney General Ravnsborg's conduct following the criminal acts, he, acting						
5	in his individual capacity and as attorney general, made numerous misrepresentations and						
6	misstatements of fact to law enforcement and the public and misused the assets of his office;						
7	and						
8	WHEREAS, the attorney general of the State of South Dakota has a duty to serve and						
9	support law enforcement, a duty to serve the executive branch of the State of South Dakota,						
10	and a duty to hold himself to a high standard of personal and professional conduct for the						
11	benefit of the public and the criminal justice system of the State of South Dakota; and						
12	WHEREAS, as a result of his criminal acts and his wrongful deeds, Attorney General						
13	Ravnsborg has lost the faith of law enforcement, the executive branch, and the people of						
14	South Dakota; and						
15	WHEREAS, it is the sense of the House of Representatives that criminally causing the						
16	death of a citizen of the State of South Dakota , committing wrongful deeds following such						
17	criminal acts, and losing the faith of law enforcement and the executive branch represent						
18	grave and exceptional circumstances meriting impeachment of Attorney General Ravnsborg:						
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Second						
20	Special Session of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, that Jason						
21	Ravnsborg, attorney general of the State of South Dakota, is impeached for crimes-and for						
22	malfeasance in office.						
23	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following articles article of impeachment areis adopted						
24	by the House of Representatives in the name of the people of the State of South Dakota and						
25	must be exhibited to the Senate.						
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in accordance with S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 5, Attorney						
27	General Ravnsborg must not exercise the duties of attorney general from the time this						
28	resolution is adopted and may resume the duties of attorney general only if acquitted by the

1 2	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that, in accordance with S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 7, the Speaker of the House shall ensure that Attorney General Ravnsborg is served with a copy of					
3	the articlesarticle of impeachment as expeditiously as possible.					
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives is directed					
5	to prepare an enrolled copy of this resolution, to be authenticated by her signature and that					
6	of the Speaker, and transmit it to the Secretary of the Senate.					
7	The following articles article of impeachment areis exhibited by the House of Representatives					
8	of the State of South Dakota against Jason Ravnsborg, attorney general of the State of South					
9	Dakota, in maintenance and support of impeachment for crimes-and for malfeasance in office.					
10	Article I for Impeachment: Crimes Causing the Death of Joseph Boever					
11	S.D. Const., Art. XVI, ξ 3 provides that the House of Representatives may impeach "state					
12	and judicial officers," for "drunkenness, crimes, corrupt conduct, or malfeasance or					
13	misdemeanors in office."					
14	Attorney General Jason Ravnsborg committed crimes causing the death of Joseph Boever,					
15	specifically:					
16	(1) On the evening of September 12, 2020, Attorney General Ravnsborg failed to operate					
17	his vehicle within its proper lane, crossed outside such lane, diverted his attention from					
18	the road, and struck pedestrian and Highmore, South Dakota, resident Joseph Boever;					
19	(2) Joseph Boever died immediately from the collision; and					
20	(3) Attorney General Ravnsborg pleaded no contest and was found guilty of two separate					
21	crimes, including illegal lane change, the crime that caused the death of Joseph					
22	<u>Boever.</u>					
23	Wherefore, this Article of Impeachment for crimes causing the death of Joseph Boever is					
24	hereby adopted, and Attorney General Jason Ravnsborg must face trial for impeachment in					
25	the Senate of the State of South Dakota pursuant to S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 2.

3 <u>Attorney General Jason Ravnsborg committed the following wrongful deeds:</u>

- 4 (1) Immediately following the collision, Attorney General Ravnsborg identified himself by
 5 his official title and made a direct misrepresentation to the dispatch officer, misleading
- 6 <u>first responders as to the crime he had just committed;</u>
- 7 (2) During the investigation, Attorney General Ravnsborg made numerous
 8 misrepresentations and misstatements of fact to law enforcement and to the public
 9 regarding his conduct surrounding his criminal acts; and
- 10 (3) Attorney General Ravnsborg used assets of the Office of the Attorney General to
- 11 <u>benefit himself personally with respect to the investigation into his criminal activity.</u>
- 12 <u>Wherefore, the foregoing wrongful deeds amount to malfeasance in office as provided in S.D.</u>
- 13 Const., Art. XVI, § 3. Accordingly, this Article of Impeachment for malfeasance in office
- 14 following the death of Joseph Boever is adopted, and Attorney General Jason Ravnsborg must
- 15 <u>face trial in the Senate of the State of South Dakota pursuant to S.D. Const., Art. XVI, § 2.</u>
