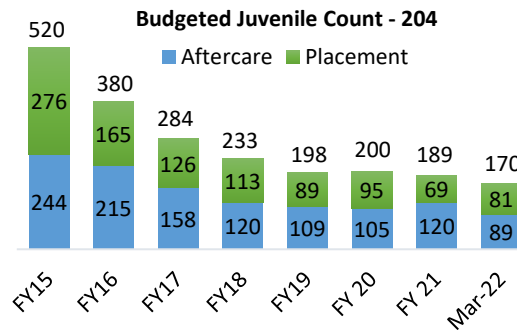

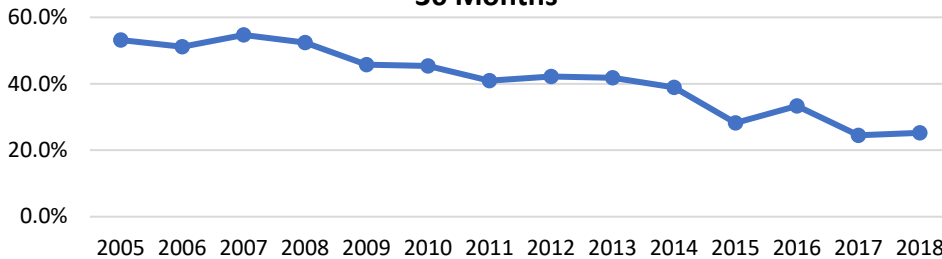
**Yearly Juvenile Admissions**



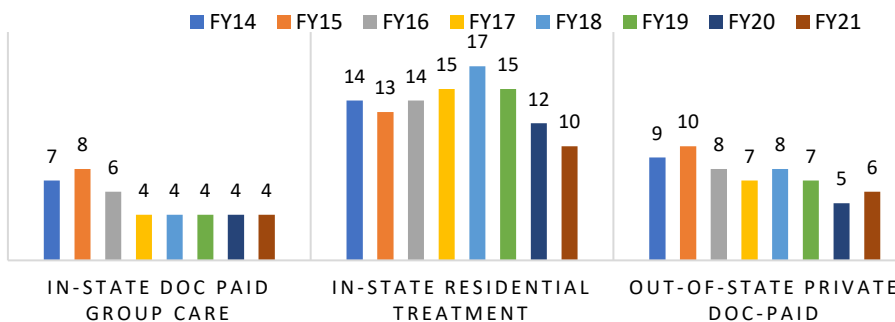
**End of Fiscal Year Juvenile
