



Program Overview



Overview

- Initiated Measure 26
- Debilitating medical condition
 - A chronic or debilitating disease or medical condition or its treatment that produces one or more of the following: cachexia or wasting syndrome; severe, debilitating pain; severe nausea; seizures; or severe and persistent muscle spasms, including those characteristic of multiple sclerosis
- Practitioner
 - A physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse, who is licensed with authority to prescribe drugs to humans. In relation to a nonresident cardholder, the term means a person who is licensed with authority to prescribe drugs to humans in the state of the patient's residence

Overview

- Medical cannabis programs generally take 2 or more years to get completely stood up
- It takes around 10-12 months for establishments to be fully functional
- Estimates from DOH have been product availability in summer/fall 2022

Medical Cannabis Patient Process Overview

StepTwo:

A determination is made by the practitioner whether the patient has a debilitating medical condition as defined in statute and cannabis may be beneficial to the patient. If yes, a medical certification is issued through the on-line portal for the patient. Physicians must create an account at medcannabisapplication.sd.gov to provide written certifications.



Patient has Medical Complaint

Step One: Patient schedules an appointment with their practitioner.



Patient Sees Their Pracitioner



Patient Applies with DOH

Step Three:

Patient receives email to create account on medcannabisapplication.sd.gov. Once compete, the patient must wait for DOH approval.

Step Four: (If Applicable)

Some applications, including minor patient applications, require caregivers to be registered. Caregivers will receive an email to create an account on medcannabisapplication.sd.gov. Once compete, the caregiver must wait for DOH approval.

Step Five:

Once the patient or caregiver gets DOH approval, a medical cannabis card will be mailed to the patient or caregiver. The cardholder may then purchase cannabis from a certified dispensary.

Please Note: Patients can NOT start the medical cannabis application process until their practitioner creates a certification, which will automatically create a patient account on medcannabisapplication.sd.gov. In South Dakota, dispensaries, not pharmacies, sell cannabis. Medical certification is not a prescription.




The purpose of this form is to collect the necessary information from qualifying patients who have been issued a written certification from a physician pursuant to SDCL 34-20G. Once the application is complete and the required payment has been made, the Department of Health will approve or deny your application within 15 days. Patient Registration Identification Cards will be issued to approved applicants and, if applicable, their Caregiver within five days of approval. 



In November 2020, South Dakota voters passed Initiated Measure 26, laying the foundation for the medical cannabis program. Since then, the South Dakota Medical Cannabis Program (SDMC) has become operational and is building business certification and patient/physician platforms. In addition to development efforts, the SDMC has also started working with the industry to implement program processes.






- Total fees collected shall generate revenues sufficient to offset all expenses of implementing and administering the program. "SDCL 20G-72-(10)(b)
- Establishment State \$5,000,
 - Local fees determined by jurisdiction
 - Application
 - Annual Renewal
- Patient Card (both resident and nonresident) \$75
- Low-income Patient Card \$20
- Caregivers
 - First caregiver free
 - Additional caregivers \$20
- 2-Part Registry (home cultivation) \$20

Looking Ahead



Petition Process

- Petitions to add a debilitating medical condition definition must include:
 - South Dakota residents
 - Description of the specific medical condition
 - Diagnostic criteria
 - Research
 - 2 Letters of support
 - Citations
- Department decision 180 days



Proposed Administrative Rule Changes

- Important Dates
 - Public Hearing: 6/21/2022
 - Comment Deadline: 7/01/2022
 - Interim Rules Committee Hearing: 7/19/2022



July 1 Program Changes

- Home Cultivation
 - 2 flowering, 2 non-flowering
 - No extended plant count
- Patient Certifications
 - Physician assistants
 - Advanced practice registered nurses
- Establishments must verify a valid photo ID prior to a person entering the premises



July 1 Program Changes

- Cannabis must be tested prior to transfer for retail sale
- Sample collection must be performed by testing establishment
- Practitioner no longer required to indicate the patient is likely to receive therapeutic or palliative benefit
- Referrals from patient's treating practitioner allowed (i.e, doesn't have to be treating physician)
