- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for the release of certain military records of
- deceased veterans.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 33A-1-21 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 33A-1-21. The contents of, and all files, records, reports, papers, and documents pertaining
- 6 to, any claim for the benefits of this chapter, or chapters 33A-2 to 33A-5, inclusive, whether
- 7 pending or adjudicated, are confidential and privileged except to the veteran, a veteran's
- 8 dependents or their duly authorized agents. Any deceased veteran's military records that are at
- 9 least seventy-five years old are available to the public for research purposes and to the veteran's
- 10 <u>family members</u>. However, investigatory material compiled solely for the purpose of
- determining suitability, eligibility, or qualifications for the benefits of this chapter, or chapters
- 12 33A-2 to 33A-5, inclusive, are exempt from release to the extent that the disclosure of the
- material would reveal the identity of the source who furnished information to the department
- under an express promise that the identity of the source would be held in confidence, or, prior
- to July 1, 1985, under an implied promise that the identity of the source would be held in
