Senate Bill 12

Introduced by: The Senate Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Department of the Military

An Act to authorize the construction of a National Guard vehicle maintenance shop
in Watertown, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an
emergency.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** The Department of the Military may contract for the construction, completion,
- 6 <u>furnishing, equipping, and maintaining of, including heating, plumbing, water, sewer, electric</u>
- 7 facilities, architectural and engineering services, and such other services or actions as may
- 8 <u>be required to construct a vehicle maintenance shop in Watertown for an estimated cost of</u>
- 9 \$29,000,000, subject to permitted adjustments pursuant to section 3 of this Act.
- 10 **Section 2.** There is hereby appropriated \$29,000,000 in federal fund expenditure authority
- 11 to the Department of the Military for purposes stated in section 1 of this Act.
- 12 **Section 3.** The Department of the Military may adjust the authorized cost estimate in section
- 13 1 of this Act to reflect inflation as measured by the building cost index reported by the
- 14 Engineering News Record, additional expenditures required to comply with regulations
- 15 adopted after the effective date of this Act, or additional sums received pursuant to section 4
- of this Act. However, any adjustments to the construction cost estimate for the project may
- 17 not exceed one hundred twenty-five percent of the appropriation stated in section 1 of this
- 18 Act.
- 19 **Section 4.** In addition to the amount appropriated in section 2 of this Act, the Department of
- 20 the Military may accept and expend for the purposes of this Act any funds obtained from gifts,
- 21 contributions, or any other source if the acceptance and expenditure is approved in
- 22 accordance with § 4-8B-10.
- 23 **Section 5.** The design and construction of this project shall be under the general charge and
- 24 supervision of the Department of the Military. The adjutant general of the Department of the

- 1 Military or the state engineer shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants
- 2 to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- 3 **Section 6.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 4 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 5 **Section 7.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 6 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act is in full
- 7 <u>force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
