Introduced by: The Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources at the request of the Public Utilities Commission

- An Act to require quarterly reporting of alleged crimes and civil proceedings involving grain transactions and to provide a penalty therefor.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 49-26 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

5		A grain buyer holding a Class A license shall provide written notification to the
6	comm	ission, at the time of submitting the quarterly balance sheet pursuant to § 49-45-
7	<u>22, if</u>	the grain buyer:
8	<u>(1)</u>	Becomes aware of:
9		(a) Embezzlement in excess of fifty thousand dollars;
LO		(b) Theft in excess of fifty thousand dollars; or
l1		(c) Fraud in excess of fifty thousand dollars, allegedly perpetrated upon the
L2		grain buyer;
L3	<u>(2)</u>	Becomes a creditor in a bankruptcy proceeding and has a claim in excess of fifty
L4		thousand dollars; or
L5	<u>(3)</u>	Becomes a party to a civil proceeding, in which there is a claim in excess of fifty
16		thousand dollars.
L7		If a willful violation of this section results in a financial loss to a grain supplier, the
18	violati	on is punishable as theft under chapter 22-30A.
