## 2023 South Dakota Legislature

## **Senate Bill 48**

Introduced by: The Committee on Judiciary at the request of the Office of the Attorney General

- An Act to enhance the penalty for attempted first degree murder of a law enforcement officer.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 22-4-1 be AMENDED:
  - **22-4-1.** Unless specific provision is made by law, any person who attempts to commit a crime and, in the attempt, does any act toward the commission of the crime, but fails or is prevented or intercepted in the perpetration of that crime, is punishable for<del>such the</del> attempt at <u>a maximum sentence</u> of one-half of the penalty prescribed for the underlying crime. However, Unless specific provision is made by law, any person who attempts to commit a Class A, Class B, or Class C felony is guilty of a Class 2 felony.
  - Section 2. That chapter 22-4 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- Notwithstanding § 22-4-1, attempted first degree murder, as defined by § 22-16-4, if committed against a law enforcement officer while the officer was engaged in the performance of the officer's duties, is a Class 1 felony.
