- 1 An Act to prohibit ranked-choice voting.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That chapter 12-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
- The State Board of Elections may not authorize and a political subdivision may not
 adopt or enforce in any manner a rule, resolution, charter provision, or ordinance
 establishing a system of voting for any office where:

 (1) Voters rank candidates in order of preference;

 (2) Tabulation proceeds in rounds where in each round either a candidate is elected or
 - (2) Tabulation proceeds in rounds where in each round either a candidate is elected or the last-place candidate is eliminated;
 - (3) Votes are transferred from elected or eliminated candidates to the voter's nextranked candidate in order of preference; and
 - (4) Tabulation ends when a candidate receives the majority of votes cast or the number of candidates elected equals the number of offices to be filled.
