SD Office Of Homeland Security

- 122 Schools have received a physical security assessment
- 110 local projects funded

School Safety Resource Center

- 122 school security assessments completed
- Trained over 60 threat assessment teams in SD
- Safe2Say South Dakota Launch on Sept. 28, 2022
 - 48 tips, 133 follow-ups
 - Personal presentations at 14 schools reaching 3000 students and 200 staff

SD Highway Patrol

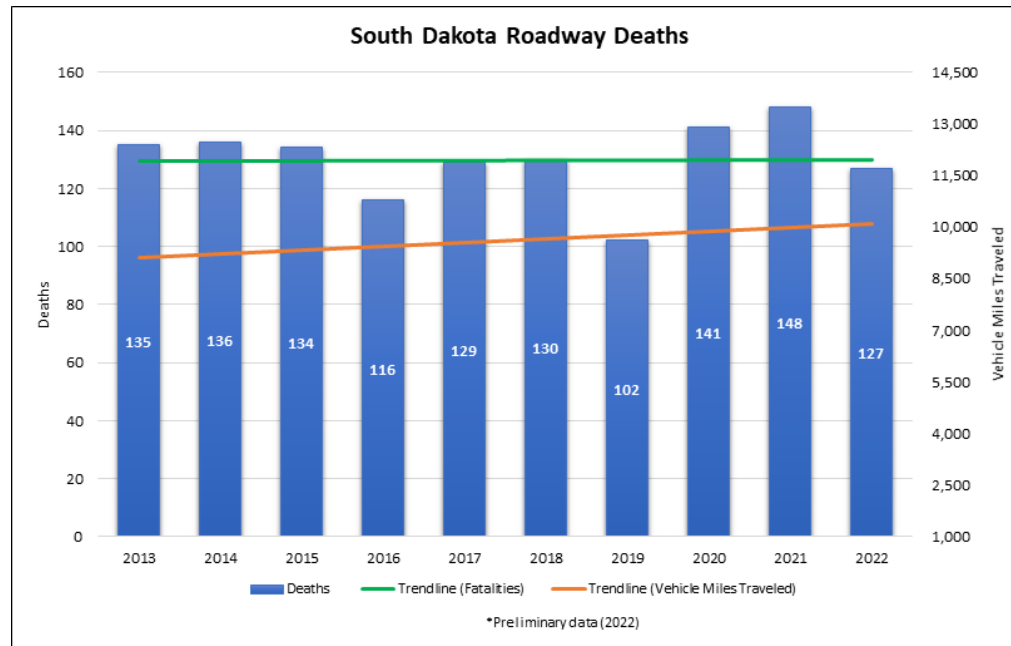
- Summer Enforcement Plans (District 2 success)
 - June/July/August – focused on roads that were predicted to have injury or fatal crashes by GIS mapping data.
 - Results – 217 injury crashes were predicted, only 88 occurred with no fatalities.
