- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 62-6 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

A case management service provider operating as required by § 58-20-24 or 62-5-21, shall notify the employee of the employee's ability to be present, whether in-person or by telephone or video conference, during any discussion between the case management service provider and a medical provider regarding the employee's case management plan. The case management service provider shall provide to the employee copies of any written correspondence regarding questions of compensability, causation, or entitlement to workers' compensation benefits, associated with the employee's case management plan, and provide a summary of the discussion between the medical provider and the case management service provider.
