SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 46 enhance the penalty for petition circulation perjury. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- SB 15 to accept Uniformed Services ID as proof of veteran status to have veteran designation added to a state license or ID card. (Introduced)
- SB 9 modify discharge notice procedures applicable to developmentally disabled persons. (Introduced)
- SB 10 expand certification options for interpreters for the deaf. (Introduced)
- SB 68 modify the approval process for certain out-of-state travel and related costs by a legislative member. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 11 update certain application fees for actions related to energy transactions in utility chargeback dockets. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 47 (Deferred from 8th LD) revise exceptions to the imposition of a Class 2 misdemeanor when no other penalty is provided by statute. (Introduced)
- SB 31 create an off-road vehicle decal for non-residents visiting the state. (Introduced)
- SB 20 (Removed from Consent) authorize the awarding of deobligated grants in accordance with policies of the Board of Water and Natural Resources. (Introduced)
- SB 69 modify the composition of the State-Tribal Relations Committee. (Introduced)
