Senate Bill 98

Introduced by: **Senator Stalzer**

1 **An Act to identify the means of conducting a criminal background check for the**
 2 **renewal of a gold card or an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That § 23-7-56 be AMENDED:**

5 **23-7-56.** A person who holds an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol may
 6 renew the permit through the sheriff of the county in which the person resides. The period
 7 for renewal begins one-hundred eighty days before the permit expires and ends thirty
 8 days after the permit expires.

9 In order to renew an enhanced permit a person shall:

- 10 (1) Pass a criminal background check consisting of a computer check of available online
 11 records and a check utilizing the National Instant Criminal Background Check
 12 System; and
- 13 (2) Present proof that:
- 14 (a) During the period for renewal, as set forth in this section, the person:
- 15 (i) Successfully completed the live fire component of a qualifying
 16 handgun course defined in § 23-7-58;
- 17 (ii) Received instruction regarding the use of force standards; and
- 18 (iii) Received instruction regarding relevant criminal statutory changes;
- 19 or
- 20 (b) The person is a current or former law enforcement officer who, within the
 21 twelve-month period preceding the date of the expiration, qualified or
 22 requalified on a certified shooting course administered by a firearms
 23 instructor approved by the Law Enforcement Officers Standards
 24 Commission.

25 If a person fails to renew an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol during
 26 the period set forth in this section, the permit is deemed to be invalid. In order to obtain

1 an enhanced permit thereafter, the person shall submit an application and meet all
2 requirements set forth in § 23-7-53.

3 **Section 2. That § 23-7-62 be AMENDED:**

4 **23-7-62.** A person who holds a gold card permit to carry a concealed pistol may
5 renew the permit through the sheriff of the county in which the person resides. The period
6 for renewal begins one hundred eighty days before the permit expires and ends thirty
7 days after the permit expires.

8 In order to renew a gold card permit, a person must pass a criminal background
9 check consisting of a computer check of available online records and a check utilizing the
10 National Instant Criminal Background Check System.
