- SCR 602 Affirming the Legislature's support of the United States Supreme Court decision of *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization*. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 50 revise the crime of witness tampering. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed) (PJPCE)
- SB 64 repeal provisions related to the jail mental health screening pilot program and oversight council. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 61 revise driver's license suspensions for restricted permit holders over the age of sixteen. (Introduced)
- SB 62 amend provisions regarding delivery of electronic insurance documents. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1010 repeal the sunset date for provisions related to the licensure of behavior analysts. (Introduced)
- HB 1015 update provisions related to the licensure of funeral directors and the provision of funeral services. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- HB 1033 provide for the uniform administration of tobacco products taxes. (Introduced)
- HB 1062 clarify the convening of recount boards for primary elections. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 3 require law enforcement notice to school officials when a student is suspected of violating state drug or alcohol laws or of threatening violence.
(Senate Education Engrossed)
- SB 71 authorize other fuel taxes to be included in the state's International Fuel Tax Agreement collections. (Introduced)
- SB 48 (Removed from Consent) enhance the penalty for attempted first degree murder of a law enforcement officer. (Introduced) (PJPCE)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1014 update provisions related to the licensure of speech-language pathologists and speech-language pathology assistants. (Introduced)
- HB 1012 (Removed from Consent) repeal the annual grievance reporting requirements for health carriers. (Introduced)
- HB 1003 repeal provisions requiring prison or jail cost estimates and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
