# Senate Bill 172

Introduced by: **Senator Breitling**

1 **An Act to increase the appropriation for construction costs related to the health**  
 2 **services center at Black Hills State University–Rapid City, and to declare an**  
 3 **emergency.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** That section 1 of chapter 198 of the 2022 Session Laws be AMENDED:

6 The Board of Regents is hereby authorized to contract for the planning, site preparation,  
 7 renovation, furnishing, equipping, and construction of an addition for a health sciences center  
 8 at Black Hills State University–Rapid City, together with furnishings and equipment, including  
 9 heating, air conditioning, plumbing, water, sewer, electric facilities, sidewalks, parking,  
 10 landscaping, architectural and engineering services, and such other facilities, services or  
 11 actions as may be required to accomplish the project authorized in this Act, for an estimated  
 12 cost of ~~\$15,114,644~~ \$20,114,644, subject to permitted adjustments pursuant to section 3 of  
 13 this Act.

14 **Section 2.** That section 2 of chapter 198 of the 2022 Session Laws be AMENDED:

15 There is hereby appropriated to the Board of Regents, for the purposes authorized in this  
 16 Act, the sum of \$5,000,000 from the general fund; the sum of \$8,000,000 in federal fund  
 17 expenditure authority from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Capital Projects Fund  
 18 moneys; the sum of \$5,114,644 in other fund expenditure authority from those portions of  
 19 the higher education facilities fund allocable to Black Hills State University and South Dakota  
 20 State University; and the sum of \$2,000,000 in other fund expenditure authority from donated  
 21 funds, together with any additional sums received pursuant to section 4 of this Act, and  
 22 permitted adjustments pursuant to section 3 of this Act.

- 1 **Section 3.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 2 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 3 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
