- SB 62 (Removed from Consent) amend provisions regarding delivery of electronic insurance documents. (Senate Commerce and Energy Engrossed)
- SB 44 (Removed from Consent) repeal provisions regarding the creation of river basin natural resource districts. (Introduced)
- SB 73 (Removed from Consent) exclude road improvement district and townshipowned self-propelled machinery, equipment, and vehicles from fuel excise tax. (Senate Taxation Engrossed)
- SB 75 (Removed from Consent) revise provisions related to parental support for expenses related to pregnancy and childbirth. (Introduced)
- SB 67 (Removed from Consent) revise provisions related to emergency and involuntary commitment for alcohol and drug abuse. (Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)

- SB 13 authorize the construction of an addition to the BG Dean Mann Readiness Center in Sioux Falls, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 101 provide the Department of Health with oversight authority for the provision of emergency medical services. (Introduced)
