AMENDMENT 80A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1 An Act to amend the requirements to be a legal newspaper.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 17-2-2.2 be AMENDED:

- 4 **17-2-2.2.** A legal newspaper shall, for at least one year prior to publication of legal
 and official notices, <u>be intended for distribution and circulation to the general public</u>,
 without regard to business, trade, or profession and must<u>either</u>:
- 7 (1) maintainMaintain a definite price of not less than fifty percent of its published price,
 8 and shall be paid for by no less than fifty percent of those to whom it is distributed 9 Such legal newspaper shall, and have a minimum paid circulation of at least two
 10 hundred and be intended for distribution and circulation to the general public,
 11 without regard to business, trade, or profession; or
- (2) <u>Maintain-In the case of a legal newspaper for a municipality of the first class or a</u>
 county having a population greater than fifty thousand, maintain a minimum of
 two hundred paid online subscribers and distribute an associated print edition at
 least fifty weeks per year with a circulation of at least five hundred copies,
 regardless of whether the print edition is made available to the public for a paid
 subscription or for free.

An owner or agent of any newspaper qualifying under subdivision 2 of this section must annually sign an affidavit stating the newspaper complies with this section. The affidavit must be printed in the newspaper in the month of October and must be filed with the governing body of each local jurisdiction that has designated the paper as a legal
