- SB 70 (Deferred from 14th LD) revise provisions related to courtroom modifications for child witnesses. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
- SB 12 (Deferred from 14th LD) authorize the construction of a National Guard vehicle maintenance shop in Watertown, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- SB 13 (Deferred from 14th LD) authorize the construction of an addition to the BG Dean Mann Readiness Center in Sioux Falls, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
