SB 75 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions related to parental support for expenses related to pregnancy and childbirth. (Introduced)  
SB 67 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions related to emergency and involuntary commitment for alcohol and drug abuse.  
(Senate Health and Human Services Engrossed)  
SB 70 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) revise provisions related to courtroom modifications for child witnesses. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)  
SB 12 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the construction of a National Guard vehicle maintenance shop in Watertown, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)  
SB 13 (Deferred from 14<sup>th</sup> LD) authorize the construction of an addition to the BG Dean Mann Readiness Center in Sioux Falls, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
