### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 145 revise provisions pertaining to township eligibility for the rural access infrastructure fund. (Introduced)

SB 102 require the continued maintenance of the official list of candidates prior to an election. (Introduced)

SB 83 revising provisions regarding water development districts. (Introduced)

HB 1013 update references to certain federal motor carrier regulations. (Introduced)

HB 1064 require the Unified Judicial System to assemble a task force to address the provision of legal services to indigent parties within the South Dakota court system and to declare an emergency. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)

HCR 6002 To encourage the Executive Board of the Legislature to continue researching childhood mental health and mental health services available to children in this state. (Introduced)

HCR 6003 Encouraging the Executive Board of the Legislature to authorize the interim legislative study of long-term care services for veterans regardless of disability ratings and to develop long-term care plans for VA-operated purchased and subsidized long-term care services. (Introduced)

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## SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 78 create the South Dakota Board of Physical Therapy and make an appropriation therefor. (Introduced)
- SB 87 establish educational standards for the expanded practice of optometry. (Introduced)
- SB 55 prohibit ranked-choice voting. (Introduced)
- SB 132 revise the appointment of legislators to the Agricultural Land Assessment Implementation and Oversight Advisory Task Force. (Introduced)
- SB 99 authorize counties to issue bonds for certain expenditures funded by a gross receipts tax. (Introduced) (PJPCE)

## SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1026 make an appropriation for costs related to suppression of wildfires in the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1027 make an appropriation for costs related to disasters in the state and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1034 modify tax refunds for elderly persons and persons with a disability, to make an appropriation therefor, and to declare an emergency. (Introduced)
- HB 1036 increase civil penalties for commercial driver's license holders and motor carriers. (House Transportation Engrossed)
- HB 1063 (Removed from Consent) require the Unified Judicial System to assemble a task force to address barriers to services for emerging adults involved in the justice system in South Dakota. (Introduced)
- HB 1057 allow for the appointment of county coroner by all counties. (Introduced)
