

## 2023 South Dakota Legislature

**House Bill 1086****AMENDMENT 1086A  
FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL**

1 **An Act to create provisions for the Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model to be**  
2 **reimbursable for insurance.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1. That chapter 58-17 be amended with a NEW SECTION:**

5 Any health insurer offering any individual or group health insurance policy,  
6 contract, certificate, or plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in South Dakota on  
7 or after January 1, 2024, and mental health or substance use disorder benefits, except  
8 for policies that provide coverage for specified disease or other limited benefit coverage,  
9 shall provide reimbursement for such benefits that are delivered through the Psychiatric  
10 Collaborative Care Model.

11 The benefit and reimbursement requirements of this section shall not apply to any  
12 policy, contract, or service that would require the state to defray the cost as specified in  
13 42 U.S.C. § 18031(d)(3)(B)(ii), as amended and in effect on January 1, 2023.

14 For purposes of this section, the term, health insurer, is defined as provided in §  
15 58-17-100.

16 For purposes of this section, the term, Psychiatric Collaborative Care Model, means  
17 an evidence-based, integrated mental health service delivery method that is provided and  
18 directed by a primary care team consisting of a primary care provider and a care manager,  
19 who provide structured care management and regular assessment of a patient's clinical  
20 status using validated tools and treatment modification as appropriate, and a psychiatric  
21 consultant, who provides regular consultations to the primary care provider and care  
22 manager to review the clinical status and care of the patient and to make  
23 recommendations for continued care.
