##### Senate Page Resolution 2

- SB 11 (Consideration of House Amendment) update the deposit threshold for actions related to general rate cases. (House Engrossed)
- HCR 6011 Celebrating the sister-state relationship with Taiwan. (Introduced)
- HCR 6002 (Removed from Consent) To encourage the Executive Board of the Legislature to continue researching childhood mental health and mental health services available to children in this state. (Introduced)
- HCR 6003 (Removed from Consent) Encouraging the Executive Board of the Legislature to authorize the interim legislative study of long-term care services for veterans regardless of disability ratings and to develop long-term care plans for VA-operated purchased and subsidized long-term care services. (Introduced)

#### SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

- SB 86 require candidates for a party precinct committee to include an email address and phone number in the written statement submitted to the county auditor. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
- SB 98 identify the means of conducting a criminal background check for the renewal of a gold card or an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol. (Introduced)

- HB 1038 revise certain provisions pertaining to the Department of Veterans Affairs and residency in the State Veterans Home. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- SB 116 authorize legislative intervention into certain cases pertaining to election law. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
- SB 145 (Removed from Consent) revise provisions pertaining to township eligibility for the rural access infrastructure fund. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1064 (Removed from Consent) require the Unified Judicial System to assemble a task force to address the provision of legal services to indigent parties within the South Dakota court system and to declare an emergency. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
