MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

HCR 6007 (Deferred from 13th LD) Affirming the importance of the constitutionally required legislative oath of office. (Introduced)

CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS OF COMMITTEES (AMENDED BILLS)

SB 140 (Consent Calendar), SB 141 (Consent Calendar)

SECOND READING OF CONSENT CALENDAR ITEMS

SB 5 extend the termination date of the Juvenile Justice Oversight Council and modify its membership requirements. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 147 change provisions regarding the appointment of legislators to represent South Dakota in the Streamlined Sales and Use Tax Agreement. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF SENATE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

SB 74 (Deferred from 14th LD) provide for the establishment of regional jail authorities. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 4 modify a court's authority to commit a habitual juvenile offender to the Department of Corrections. (Senate Judiciary Engrossed)
SB 133 modify the design of license plates to include the state motto. (Introduced)
SB 86 (Removed from Consent) require candidates for a party precinct committee to include an email address and phone number in the written statement submitted to the county auditor. (Senate Local Government Engrossed)
SB 116 (Deferred from 17th LD) authorize legislative intervention into certain cases pertaining to election law. (Senate State Affairs Engrossed)
SB 145 (Deferred from 17th LD) revise provisions pertaining to township eligibility for the rural access infrastructure fund. (Introduced)
SB 88 amend a provision allowing municipalities to jointly license and regulate intercity services. (Introduced)
SB 162 revise public meeting requirements. (Introduced)
SJR 505 Proposing and submitting to the electors at the next general election an amendment to the Constitution of the State of South Dakota, updating references to certain officeholders and persons. (Introduced)

SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILLS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS

- HB 1057 (Deferred from 16th LD) allow for the appointment of county coroner by all counties. (Introduced)
- HB 1064 (Deferred from 17th LD) require the Unified Judicial System to assemble a task force to address the provision of legal services to indigent parties within the South Dakota court system and to declare an emergency.
