AMENDMENT 86B FOR THE SENATE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENGROSSED BILL

1 An Act to require candidates for <u>a</u> party precinct <u>committee committeeman or</u> 2 <u>committeewoman</u> to include an email address and phone number in the 3 written statement submitted to the county auditor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 12-5-4 be AMENDED:

- 6 **12-5-4.** A candidate for party precinct <u>committeeman or committeewoman</u> 7 <u>committeeman or committeewoman</u> shall file a statement in writing, with the county 8 <u>auditor of the county in which he or she is a candidate, with the county auditor of the</u> 9 <u>county in which he or she is a candidate</u>, not later than the last Tuesday in March before 10 the primary election. The statement <u>shall must include the candidate's email address and</u> 11 <u>phone number and must</u> state that the candidate:
- 12 (1) Is a resident of the precinct;
- 13 (2) Is registered as a member of the political party named in the statement;
- 14 (3) Is a candidate for precinct committeeman or committeewoman, as the case may
 15 be committeeman or committeewoman, as the case may be;
- 16 (4) Is desirous of serving in that position; and
- 17 (5) If elected, will qualify and serve in the office.
- 18 The statement, when properly filed, <u>shall operate</u> operates as a nominating petition

19 for that office.
